We are working on a few projects:

We are sending violation notices to homeowners regarding the mold and mildew on homes, and overgrown flower beds, etc. Please be proactive in cleaning your property. See Deed Restrictions below:

*(p) All flower beds, planting areas and similar areas on all lots must be kept free of weeds and overgrowth. Lot owners are responsible for removal of mildew from their home. Shrubs and trees must be pruned when needed. Dead shrubs and limbs must be removed. Trees which are removed must have the trunks (base of tree) ground down below the surface of the lawn. Should any lot owner fail to do the above, the District's Board of Trustees may provide for the said service at the lot owner's expense after reasonable notice has been given. Any unpaid fee for said service shall become a lien on the property where said service is provided.*

I want to thank all the residents that complied with violation notices that were sent. It is much appreciated. We want to keep Holiday Park a beautiful place to live. If you are going home for the summer, please ensure the Office has your correct information on file, forwarding address, phone number, and caretaker. Please text the word **holidaypark** to 941-214-7989. This will enable you to receive text alerts. If you have questions or concerns. My door is always open, and I can meet you in the park or

my office. My email and phone numbers are listed on my business card. Suggestions are welcome.

## DID YOU KNOW.....

- HPARC has a Council Member whose sole responsibility is to welcome new homeowners and renters and answer any questions they might have.
- Any work done outside of your home, including landscaping must have an Architectural Control Committee (ACC) permit.
- Due to the Florida Sunshine Law, Trustees can only discuss agenda items and park issues with other Trustees at open meetings.
- You do not have to be a Florida Resident to be on the HPARC council, however it is a requirement to be a Trustee.
- It is against Florida law to feed wildlife, including alligators.



## HOLIDAY PARK SAFETY

We were informed by the North Port police Department at their presentation on February 1, 2024 that Holiday Park is a very safe community to live in. If you come by golf cart, please park all the way back behind the trees where people have their tables and chairs set up. If you have set your table and chairs near the shuffleboard court, please park alongside the courts. DO NOT drive golf carts on the pavers in the sidewalks between the parking lot, the shuffleboard court, and the kitchen. Golf cart parking is also available in the designated spaces of the parking lots in front of and on the side of the club house. The change in parking for the picnics is to give the workers room to get from the charcoal cooker to the serving tables and to the beverage area. Please do not park in spaces obviously designated for cars. The entry ways will be the same as always—on both sides of the big tree. PLEASE DO NOT ENTER area marked with caution tape. Please abide by the NO PARKING lines. Sometimes golf carts, scooters, bikes, and cars are parked on these painted lines which mean NO PARKING in this space. This is important so that there is always access for emergency vehicles if they are needed. It's important to remember that all residential lots of Holiday Park are private property and require permission from the owners if you want to walk across or park on their property.

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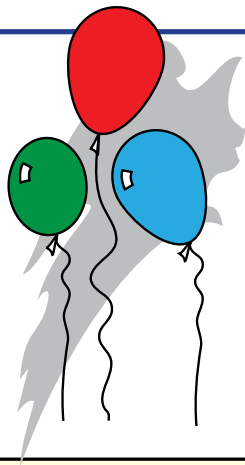

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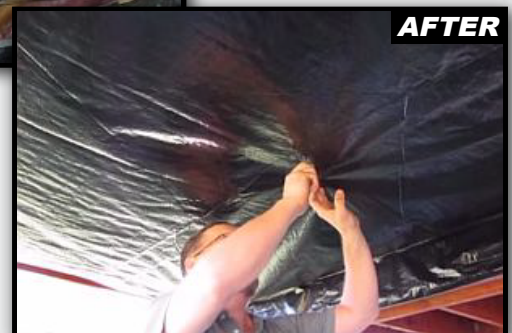
