—Board of Trustees—

Of course, the purchase of homes in HP by MH Liquidity Solutions, LLC has many concerned that our lifestyle will be negatively affected. Some have voiced concern that should the company acquire more than half of the units, they will be able to control the Board of Trustees and/or sell the park to their corporation. Let me put these homeowners and residents somewhat at ease.

Holiday Park and Recreation District was formed through legislation passed by the Florida Legislature, and is known as HB1855. This legislation authorizes the Board of Trustees to run the Park (Section 3). The only residents who can vote in elections for trustees are registered Florida voters who live in the Park. Period ((Section 5). Homeowners who do not live in the park, or who are not registered voters at their HP address may not vote for a Trustee. No corporation which owns even most homes in Holiday Park may elect even one trustee. They have no vote.

In order to abolish the Park, the Trustees would be required to place the issue on the ballot. The measure would have to be approved by a majority of registered voters (residents, not necessarily owners) voting in an election run by the Sarasota Election Supervisor. (Section 15, 19). Unlikely! A sale of all or part of Park property is a power of the elected Board. And, these rules outlined in HB1855 can only be changed by the Florida Legislature, signed by the Governor. Again, unlikely!

Also, please understand that since you own your home and lot, no one can force you to sell.

Under our deed restrictions, those restrictions may be changed by placing a change on the ballot by either 2/3 vote of the Board of Trustees, or signature of 10% of the lot owners. Then they would be sent to the ballot wherein the majority of the lot owners would be needed to pass – not a majority of those voting. As you may be aware, the Board of Trustees is proposing a deed restriction which would require the lot owner and owner of a home on the lot to be the same person. Although we now have a situation where all homes in Holiday Park are owned by the lot owner, we do not believe it would be in the long-term interest of the Park to have a situation where lots and homes are owned by different entities. This brings such questions as; Who is responsible for maintaining the home? Who is notified when a home is in violation of our deed restrictions or Rules and Regulations? Who owes the maintenance fee? Is the Board of Trustees to serve the interest of the homeowner, or the lot owner? More importantly, we believe it creates a greater sense of community when all homeowners are equal in their ownership of Holiday Park. A two-tiered system is fraught with problems we are better avoiding. We have been lucky we have not faced this problem

to date, but it is possible in the future.

I urge all homeowners of Holiday Park to consider the proposed deed restrictions carefully and please, please cast your vote so that it is received by November 4 at 3pm.

**BICYCLE REGULATIONS**

Note for residents in Holiday Park. Two items from the 55 Alive Driving Class that are especially pertinent in Holiday Park. Golf carts and bikers must follow the same rules as cars. The following are the rules and **NEW** categories for the 2020 Holiday Park Computer Club Photo Contest. **PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING VERY CAREFULLY SINCE THERE ARE NUMERUS CHANGES:**

**1. WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?** Any resident of Holiday Park, **owner or renter**, may participate in the HP Computer Club Photo Contest. It is **not** required that you be a member of the Computer Club to participate in the Photo Contest, although we'd **welcome your membership!**

**2. Previous winners are welcome.** However, you may **NOT** resubmit a previous winning photograph. This applies to 1st; 2nd; and 3rd place as well as Honorable Mention. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

**3. Submitted photographs MUST be the work of the individual submitting the photograph(s) and NOT from other sources, i.e. the internet or other photographers. EXCEPTION: IF the HP Computer Club decides to print photographs for the participants, as was done in the 2019 Contest, this will be the ONLY EXCEPTION.**

**4. This year there will be two (2) classifications for photographers:**

**A. Beginners:** A "Beginner" is an individual that has **NEVER** participated in a Photo Contest or won a prize for a photograph that they took.

**B. Advanced:** An individual that has, at one time or another, participated in a Photo Contest and was awarded a prize, regardless of the significance of the recognition. A recognition of some type was awarded places the participant in the Advanced Classification.

There will be eight (8) categories for this year's contest. They are as follows:

**1. Black & White:** Any subject that the photographer chooses to submit that is **NOT color. IT must be in BLACK & WHITE ONLY.**

**2. Plant Life:** Living or dead, not blossoms only but a "**PLANT**".

**3. Transportation:** Cars; trucks; bicycles; horse

**drawn carriages/buggies; scooters, etc. The subject MUST be related to some form of transportation. Let your imagination run wild!**

**4. Sunsets: NOT sunrises**

**5. Children:**

**6. "Left Behind":** This can be anything that has been abandoned. Old cars, trucks, boats, bicycles, toys, buildings, etc. It doesn't matter as long as the subject of the photograph is no longer being used.

**7. Antiques:**

**8. Animals:** Deer, squirrels, spiders, snakes, etc. Birds **"ARE NOT"** animals. Pictures of birds **WILL NOT** be accepted if submitted.

At the time of Judging the Judges will have the option of disqualifying a photograph, if in their opinion, the photograph submitted does not fit the category it was submitted in. It is, and will be, the responsibility of the submitting photographer to select the appropriate Category for the photograph submitted. The decision of the judges **WILL be FINAL!**

The number of photographs per category shall be limited to two (2) per contestant. **NO MORE** than 16 photographs per contestant shall be allowed. There will be **NO EXCEPTIONS** to this rule.

Entry forms will be provided. PLEASE, DO NOT write on the back of the photographs or **tape the entry form to the back of the photograph(s)** submitted for judging.

**ALL** photographs **SHALL** be printed on **PHOTO PAPER** that is 8 x 10 or 8.5 x 11; glossy or matte; with or without borders. Photographs printed on "**card stock**" **WILL NOT** be accepted. Printing can be done at home, at CVS, Walgreens, Walmart, Staples or by a member of the HP Computer Club if they agree to print photographs again this year. There will be a nominal charge to cover HP Computer Club expenses.
