Holiday Park Rules and Regulations

- R. Liquid Propane Gas (LPG) tanks used for in-home appliances
 - a. LPG tanks used for in-home appliances which are installed by other than an LPG provider must have approval of the Architectural Control Committee prior to installation and must have a City of North Port building permit.
 - b. All tanks must be on concrete blocks and be secured to the ground with 2 steel cables (one on each side of the tank) securely attached to steel anchors driven a minimum of 36" into the ground.
 - c. All LPG tanks installed by other than an LPG provider must comply with the above regulations on or before June 1, 2019. Failure to comply after notice may result in disconnect and removal of the tank by Holiday Park at the homeowner's expense.
