Dear Holiday Park Residents,

I hope everyone is enjoying a safe and relaxing summer. Although this is typically a quieter time of year, there has been no shortage of activity as we

continue making improvements throughout Holiday Park and planning for future projects.

One of our most significant accomplishments this month has been the continued progress on the Pavilion and Men's Club Storage Building projects. We recently met with the City of North Port Planning and Zoning Department to review the permitting requirements, and their guidance has helped move these projects forward. We appreciate your patience as we work through the permitting process, which is a critical step toward construction.

Stormwater and drainage improvements continue to make excellent progress. These infrastructure upgrades are designed to improve stormwater flow, reduce standing water in several areas of the community, and help protect Holiday Park for years to come. The approved Phase 1 locations have now been completed, and work is scheduled to begin on the approved Phase 2 locations in mid-August. Once the drainpipe installation is complete, all affected areas will be repaved, restoring the roadways and completing this phase of this important improvement project. Thank you for your patience and cooperation as we continue investing in Holiday Park's infrastructure.

Thank you to everyone who attended the training sessions on our new fitness center equipment. It was wonderful to see so many residents taking advantage of this opportunity to learn how to safely and effectively use the new equipment. We hope you enjoy these improvements for many years to come.

During June, we completed community-wide property inspections. I sincerely appreciate the many homeowners who have already corrected their violations or contacted me with an action plan. Working together helps preserve the beauty, safety, and property values of our community. As hurricane season continues, please remember to review your emergency plans and secure any outdoor furniture, decorations, or other loose items whenever severe weather is forecast. Preparation before a storm arrives is the best

way to protect your home and our community.

When calling 911 tell dispatchers that you live in North Port. Calls go into Charlotte County, so it helps them to know your exact location and saves valuable time.

PAVILION COMMITTEE UPDATE

RFH Construction submitted paperwork for a Certificate of Zoning Compliance, however, the city determined that the project would instead require a Site Development Plan Amendment. This review process is substantially more extensive than a typical accessory structure permit and requires additional site planning, engineering, and review by multiple city departments.

Engineering for both the pavilion structure and slab has been completed, and manufacturing of the pavilion has already begun. The sit survey has also been completed and incorporated into the project documents.

A meeting with North Port Planning and Zoning staff has been arranged to review all project requirements and ensure we fully understand any remaining site development and permitting requirements so we can continue moving the project forward as efficiently as possible.

You may also be interested in the Men's Club storage building progress adjacent to the Thrift Store in Phase 2. RFH is continuing to work through the permitting process. The information obtained during the Planning and Zoning meeting will also help us determine the requirements and next steps for permitting the storage building.

2026/2027 Picnics & Parking

If you come by golf cart, please park all the way back behind the trees where people have their tables and chairs set up.

If you have set your table and chairs near the shuffleboard court, please park alongside the courts.

DO NOT drive golf carts on the pavers in the sidewalks between the parking lot, the shuffleboard court, and the kitchen. Golf cart parking is also available in the designated spaces of the parking lots in front of, and on the side of the club house. This gives the workers room to get from the charcoal grill to the serving tables and to the beverage area. Please do not park in spaces obviously designated for cars. The entry ways will be the same as always—on both sides of the big tree. PLEASE DO NOT ENTER area marked with caution tape. Please abide by the NO PARKING lines. This is important so that there is always access for emergency vehicles if they are needed. It's important to remember that all residential lots of Holiday Park are private property and require permission from the owners if you want to walk across or park on their property.

SAFETY

I hope that everyone is having a good summer. Please remember to stay hydrated and avoid outdoor activities during the hottest time of the day.

Please everyone, remember that you must wear your name badge whenever you're out and about. Park ID Badges must be worn by all residents, including owners, non-resident owners, renters and any guests visiting Holiday Park while using all Park facilities and while in any common areas. We had a recent incident where a resident was not wearing their name badge and had no other identification on them. They were injured while on an e-bike and unconscious, NPPD had to come and identify them. This is an example of why name badges are so important. I hear so often from



residents, "I don't need to wear it because everyone knows me," but that is not true. We have many new residents here and everyone doesn't know each other. Please wear your name badges.

Bicyclists, remember, NO bicycles of any type (including e-bikes) can use the vehicle gates. You must use the pedestrian gate. We don't want to see residents being struck by the bar.

Please make sure your home has the proper house numbers. This is covered in ACC rule no. 24: Street Address Numbers conforming to city requirements must be attached to the front of the coach in a visible area. Numbers must be a minimum of four (4) inches high and no larger than twelve (12) inches high. The four inch minimum is a city requirement. This will help NP Fire/Rescue locate your residence during an emergency.

Please remember to follow the posted speed limit of 15 mph for everyone's safety! I would hate to see anyone have an accident or someone get hurt. Let's all keep our speed at 15 mph or less!

As always, if there is any suspicious activity in the park, please contact North Port PD. Call 911 for emergency assistance or for nonemergency issues, call them at (941)429-7300.

IMPORTANT GOLF CART INFORMATION

FLORIDA LAW - Effective October 1, 2023

Golf cart drivers under the age of 18 must be at least 15 with a learner's permit or 16 with a driver's license. Anyone who is 18 or older needs a valid government issued ID.

This change in the law is due to the number of children injured and killed while driving golf carts. Please keep your grandchildren safe and do not allow them to drive your golf cart.

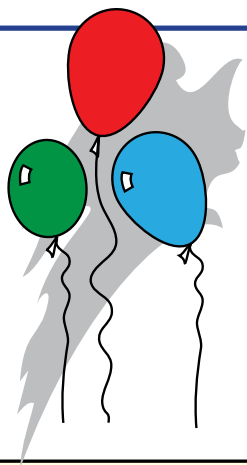

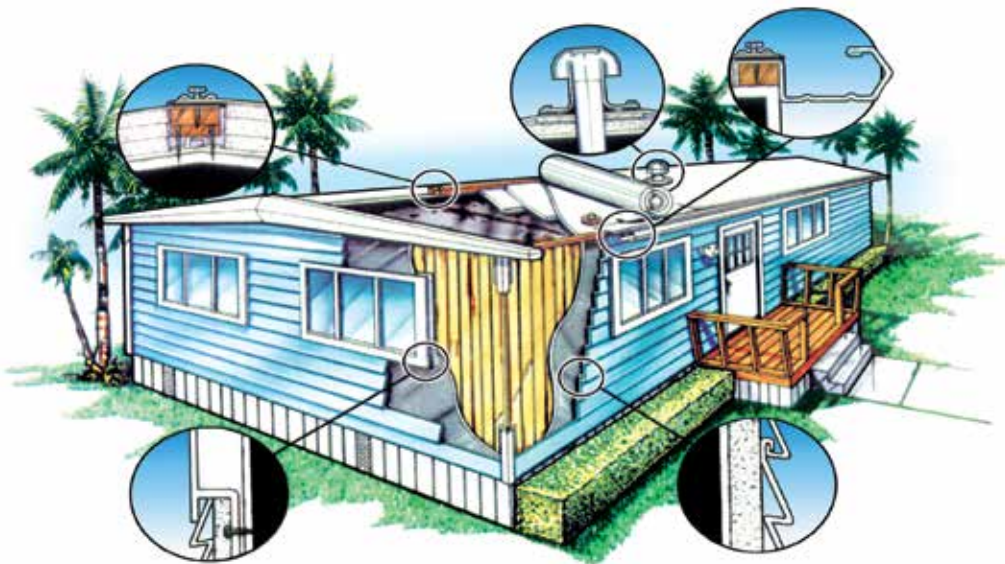


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
